

## Club Matches

Elton Furze GC runs several teams representing the Club at all levels of ability.

Men play in the Cambridgeshire Scratch League, in county and national knockouts and in a variety of friendly matches. Club colours are red sweaters, white shirts and dark trousers or shorts.

Ladies play in the Northamptonshire Cecil Leitch handicap competition, in county and national knockouts and in a variety of friendly matches. Club colours are red sweaters, white shirts and dark trousers or shorts.

An annual programme of mixed matches is organised by the Ladies' Vice-Captain.

The Club's Juniors' Organiser arranges matches against other local clubs. Club colours are red sweaters, white shirts and dark trousers or shorts.

The Seniors' Section plays numerous matches each year and, in keeping with the ethos of the Club, teams may include any combination of men and women. Club colours are navy blue sweaters, white shirts and dark trousers or shorts.

In some matches a change of clothing may be required afterwards.

Sometimes matches include breakfast before play or a meal afterwards and whenever this is the case players are expected to join in fully and pay the associated costs.

Club members who would like to play in matches should sign up on relevant sheets put on noticeboards from time to time. Shortly before each match the Captain will select a final team and post it on the same noticeboard. Shortly afterwards team members should initial against their names to confirm their availability and commitment to play.
