

Use of Buggies

Players may use powered buggies when playing in competitions only if they have a medical certificate for a temporary or permanent medical condition that would prevent them from walking the course.

Players who wish to use a buggy under such terms must submit their medical certificate (or note from their doctor) to the Secretary of the General Committee. This can be done in two ways:

- Place a paper copy of the certificate in the Secretary's mail slot in the cupboard next to the entry to the bar, or
- Send a scanned copy of the certificate to efgcsecretary@gmail.com

The certificate must make clear whether it is for a permanent condition or, if it is for a temporary condition, its expiry date.

This requirement was agreed at a committee meeting held on 4 August 2015 and the Committee wishes to make clear that it wants to encourage members' participation in competitive golf even when medical conditions make this difficult. However, to ensure fairness to all competitors the Committee wishes to formalize the official submission of medical certificates and ensure that their currency is maintained.
