- The Professional's Shop
- Deciding the Club Dress Code and enforcing standards
- Deciding on standards and maintaining them
- Ensuring that pace of play on the course, but outside of competitions for which the Committee is responsible, is within recommended guidelines
- Handling suggestions and complaints
- Health & Safety
- Working with the General Committee on areas of common interest
- Working with the Captains on developing the Club Diary
- Deciding on when the course is unplayable

Committee Responsibilities

The Elton Furze Golf Club General Committee is elected by the members of the Golf Club.

The Chairman (male or female) is supported by the Secretary, the Treasurer and several other people who have specific responsibilities for running aspects of the Club.

The General Committee is responsible for:

- Organising Competitions
- Ensuring that the Rules of Golf, CONGU regulations and the requirements of England Golf are applied and maintained
- Taking action to ensure an appropriate pace of play is maintained during competitions
- Maintaining player handicaps in accordance with CONGU requirements
- Maintaining a 'Competitions' Bible' to ensure that over the years competitions follow an agreed format
- Organising Open competitions
- Organising members' social events
- Ensuring the financial income from competitions and social events is properly looked after and accounted
- Organising an Annual General Meeting for the election of committee members, the presentation of an audited income/expenditure account and the approval of significant changes
- Working with the proprietor to produce an annual diary of competitions and events
- Ensuring members' views are drawn to the proprietor's attention when necessary
- Dealing with complaints relating to members' conduct on the golf course during competitions
